
# From the East

# A Short Lesson on Time

One of the hidden, or "covered" symbols of Freemasonry is found in the many references to time.

The Entered Apprentice with a twenty-four inch gauge as is taught to divide it wisely. The Fellowcraft is reminded the function of geometry as to time is emphasized; "by it, also, the astronomer is enabled to make his observations and the fix the duration of time and seasons, years and cycles." As a Master Mason we are reminded of the passage of time in the reading from Ecclesiastes; "the days of thy youth" to that hour when "shall the dust return to the earth as it was; and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it."

The hour glass, an instrument used for the measurement of time, is one of the symbols discussed in the lecture of the Sublime Degree. "The Scythe is an emblem of time, which cuts the brittle thread of life and launches us into eternity.
