Dues are required to be paid by December 31, 2009 or you will be considered delinquent on January 1, 2010. DUES are \$73.00. By the way the billing is a courtesy. The CMC does not require the lodge to send a dues statement. Also, this is the time of the year that finances become short. If you cannot afford the \$73.00, please let me or the Lodge Master know. If you do not keep your dues current you may be in jeopardy of being suspended. Now this is difficult for me to write. Some members decide that if they don't pay dues the lodge will just drop them.
