The financial report for the period January 1st to June 30th will be read at our August stated meeting. It should be noted that there are still 20 members who have not paid the 2018 dues. The dues for 2018 are \$60.00




per year the Grand Lodge tax is \$49.00 for 2018 for a total of \$109.00 The lodge must pay to the Grand Lodge \$49.00 for each of the 20 members who have not paid. This amounts to a \$980.00 loss to the lodge. Please brethren, check your dues receipt and if is expired on December 31, 2017 send a check to the Secretary made out to Crow Canyon Lodge 551.
