What is the benefit if any? Well, you don't cost the lodge Brethren any funds and, who knows, you might be entitled to a dues refund. Also, holding a demit, you continue to be a member at large for one year from the date of the issuance. You can visit lodges, hold Masonic communication and, within the year, you may want to be reinstated or join another lodge. But consider this—NO Masonic Outreach benefits. NO Masonic Home. Questions? 
